### NOTICE

As directed by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, University of Gour Banga, this is to inform all concerned that the Notification No.: 507 - Edn(CS)/10M-95/14, Dated 30.06.2022 (Copy attached) as issued by the Department of Higher Education, Government of West Bengal is to be strictly followed. The guidelines relating to online Admission for 3 Year Semester wise B.A./B.SC./B.COM./BCA/B.VOC./LLB (Honours/General) Programmes of studies under CBCS for the Academic Session 2022-23 are mentioned below:

#### GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSION:

##### 1. Important Dates:

##### 2. Minimum Eligibility Criteria:

- Honours Programme:** A student who has passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination held by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent Examination from other Boards / Councils with at least four subjects having English as Compulsory Subject of 100 marks is eligible to take admission to the Honours Programmes of Studies of B.A./B.Sc./B.Com./B.C.A. on the basis of merit and available vacancy of the particular subject(s) of the concerned college.
- General Programme:** A student who has passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination held by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent Examination from other Boards/Councils with at least four subjects having English as Compulsory Subject of 100 marks is eligible to take admission to the General Programmes of Studies of B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. on the basis of merit and available vacancy of the particular subject(s) of the concerned college.
- A student who has passed Higher Secondary (10+2) examinations (with English as a subject) of the West Bengal State Council of Technical & Vocational Education and Skill Development (Erstwhile West Bengal State Council of Vocational Education and Training) or National or State Level Board in regular mode shall be eligible to take admission to the B.A./B.Com General Programme only.
- Students who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Examinations in the current year, immediate previous year and the year before the previous year will only be allowed to take admission.
- Aggregate marks shall be calculated by adding the marks in English and top-three subjects in order of marks secured by a candidate.
- The College authorities may fix higher eligibility criteria than the minimum eligibility criteria as laid down in point (a) & point (b).

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### 3. Reservation of seats:

There shall be reservation of seats for SC / ST / OBC / Differently-abled Candidates as per Rules of the State Government.

### 4. Merit Point Calculation:

(a) Subject to the eligibility criteria, the merit lists for the Honours Programme will be prepared as:

(i)  $(S+T)/4$

[Where S = Subject marks (opted for Honours Programme) and T = Marks obtained in English + best marks of two other subjects (excluding subject opted for Honours Programme)].

(ii) In case, any candidate opts for an Honours Programme beyond his/her subject combination

[except linguistic subjects at H.S. (10+2) level], the merit point will be calculated as:  $T1/4$ .

[Where T1 = Marks obtained in English + best marks of three other subjects (excluding English)].

b) Subject to the eligibility criteria, the merit lists for the General Programme will be prepared as:

$T1/4$

[Where T1 = Marks obtained in English + best marks of three other subjects (excluding English)].

**5. Special conditions for admission:** A student shall be allowed to take up a subject in Honours / General Programme if he /she has passed in that subject at the previous qualifying examination subject to some exceptions for specified subjects. The detail subject combinations are mentioned below:
